Considerations & Next Steps

- All schools will have an assistant principal
- Months of employment are aligned with state allocations, but the district will offer supplemental days for needed work.
- We will maintain the Alamance Virtual School for Grades 6-12 and eliminate Grades 4 & 5 due to low enrollment.
- Elimination of additional Central Office Staff

Continuation Budget

Addresses ongoing operational needs and unfunded costs from the 2023 - 2024 school year.
